Visit Imjingak, the park has many statues and monuments. Imjingak is where the "Bridge of Freedom" lies. The Freedom Bridge does actually cross the Imjin River; it is a former railroad bridge which was used by repatriated POWs/soldiers returning from the north. See the the Odusan Unification Observatory just north of Seoul. The observatory is located on a hill that is strategically perched overlooking the confluence of both the Imjim and Han Rivers that creates the border with North Korea. Back to Seoul. Enjoy the Namsan Cable car runs from the base of Namsan Mountain up to the Namsan Tower, one of the most representative tourist attractions in Seoul, loved by tourists and residents alike. **Enjoy the Jeongdong Theater Korea Traditional Performance show**, is a special treat as it is one of the best traditional Korean art performance centers that have been highly praised. The dynamic modern recreations of the highlights of Korea's traditional art in dancing, instruments, folk music and songs

**DAY 04: SEOUL**

Visit Gyeongbok Palace, is a royal palace, first constructed in 1394 and reconstructed in 1867, it was the main and largest palace of the Five Grand Palaces built by the Joseon Dynasty. Visit Blue House, is the executive office and official residence of the President of the Republic Of Korea. The Blue House is in fact a complex of buildings, built largely in the traditional Korean architectural style with some modern elements. Proceed to Myeongdong shopping street, the fashion trends start here in Korea. **DAY 05: SEOUL – BALI**
