DAY 01: CHECK-IN AT LOS ANGELES AIRPORT EARLY MORNING (D)

DAY 03: SHERIDAN – LITTLE BIG HORN – CODY (B/D)

Take a trip into Montana within the Crow Reservation visiting the Little Bighorn battlefield. Continue our journey through the wide-open spaces of Montana and enroute to Cody, Wyoming. Visit the world-famous Buffalo Bill Historical Center known for its wild west exhibits.
