

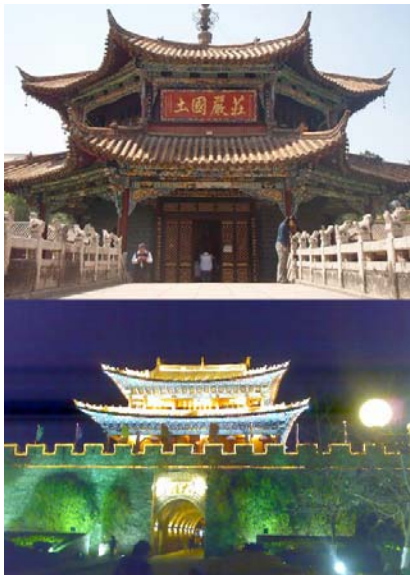

Sightseeing Schedule:

- Kunming:** Capital of Yunnan province and known as the “Eternal Spring City”, Kunming has the best year-round weather in all of China. Xishan Park, the Dragon Gate, Dianchi Lake and Grand View Pavilion. The Stone Forest, a region of limestone cliffs and peaks and natural stone “trees”, carved by wind and water over millions of years. In the afternoon, visit Jiuxiang, or its limestone caves, underground waterfall and awesome gorge. Dinner with the Yunnan minority music show
- Dali:** Home to the Bai Minority Group. Cruise on The Erhai Lake, stopping on the way at “The Three Elegant Pagodas”. In the evening, experience the old town’s upbeat nightlife, bars and coffee houses.
- Lijiang:** A World Cultural Heritage Site and a cultural center of the Naxi Minority. Black Dragon Ponds. Jade Dragon Snow Mountain, the mythical mountain worshipped by the Naxi people. Board a chair lift to see beautiful views of the Thirteen Peaks and enjoy the fantastic outdoor production called “Impression Lijiang” directed by an Internationally famous director YiMau Zhang. Later, visit Bashai. Take a motor coach ride to the famed Shangri-La, the home to the Tibetan Minority Group and made famous by the novel “Lost Horizon” by James Hilton. Shuhe Old Town. Tiger Leaping Gorge. Songzan Temple, the largest lamasery outside of Tibet. Later, visit Napahai, a beautiful scenic spot.
- Shanghai:** China’s largest city and so-called “Paris of East” with a population of over 14 million. It is a striking blend of European-style buildings standing alongside ancient Chinese structures. *2010 Expo Shanghai China*, a huge area in the core of the city dedicated to exhibits,



events and forums on sustainable and harmonious urban living. Whole day free. In the evening, enjoy the famous Shanghai Acrobats Show. On day 12, take the Wuxi city tour to the famous Yuantoudu Park, built by Lake Taihu.

Suzhou: This “Venice of the East” is built around the Grand Canal and has many superb classical gardens which earned its nickname “Garden City”. The Humble Administrator’s Garden, Hanshan Temple, and the Grand Canal, Tiger Hill and Silk factory. Yu Garden, the bustling Nanjing road and the famous waterfront Bund.
