Itinerary:

Day 01: Check in at **Los Angeles Airport (LAX)** in the evening. Meet with the AV Travel Tour Leader, an experienced, professional guide who can speak English and Vietnamese fluently.

Day 02: **New York** is the financial capital of the US and its most populous city. Start with a visit at Ground Zero in memory of the September 11 tragedy. Board the ferry from Battery Park for a cruise to Liberty Island to visit the Statue of Liberty. Continue to tour the city by visiting Wall Street, Midtown Manhattan (the largest business center) and famous landmarks: Empire State Building, Chrysler Building, Rockefeller Center and Times Square.



- Day 03:** From New York, take a ride to **Philadelphia**, the birthplace of the nation. Visit Independence Hall with the statue of the first American president, George Washington, and the Liberty Bell, a symbol of freedom for all Americans. In the afternoon, visit **Washington DC**, the US capital, and its famous federal government buildings such as the White House, Capitol Hill, the Pentagon and the Presidential & War Memorials in the National Mall.
- Day 04:** Depart from Virginia for **Niagara Falls**, along the way, visit of two famous business outlets, Hershey's Chocolate World and Corning Glass Center. Continue the journey to the Niagara Falls. After dinner, stroll along the city sidewalks to enjoy the view of the falls in the colorful lights from the Canadian side.
- Day 05:** Visit the Niagara Falls in the morning to appreciate the most beautiful views that Mother Nature created. Take the Maid of the Mist boat ride to enjoy a breathtaking close-up experience of the three falls (American, Bridal Veil and Horseshoe) and their thunderous sound. At noontime, arrive in **Toronto**, the largest city in Canada and enjoy some fresh fruits imported from Asia. Visit downtown Toronto's great architectures such as CN Tower, Roger's Stadium, the futuristic City Hall, the classical Ontario's Parliament House and the University of Toronto. Stay overnight in Kingston.
- Day 06:** Take the first cruise at **Thousand Islands** in the morning to view the many islands lining along the US and Canadian border, admiring the castles and multi-million summer residences. Arrive in **Montreal** around noon and see Vieux Montreal with its European style old neighborhoods reminiscent of Paris, France. Visit Notre Dame Cathedral and Oratory Saint Joseph, a sacred place famous for numerous miracles. Stay overnight in **Quebec City**.
- Day 07:** Stroll around Vieux Quebec, the old section of town, in the morning to enjoy the views and the classical architectures, and Chateau Frontenac, the Quebec's Parliament House. Wander in the lovely Petit Champlain to enjoy the ambiance of classic French culture and the environment of the 18th century. At noontime, continue the journey toward **Boston**. Cross the US-Canadian border (don't forget to shop at Duty Free stores). Arrive in Boston in the evening to enjoy a famous Boston lobster dinner.
- Day 08:** Tour Boston, America's center for higher education and a historical landmark. Look around the campus of world-renowned universities like Harvard and MIT. Walk along the Freedom Trail to visit the historical architectures and monuments related to the 1776 American Revolution. Stroll around Quincy market before heading back to New York.
- Day 09:** Complete your stay in New York by visiting the United Nations Headquarters and shopping at Fifth Avenue's numerous stores. Fly back to Los Angeles.
