DAY 01: CHECK-IN AT LOS ANGELES AIRPORT IN THE EVENING.

Meet with the AV Travel Tour Leader, an experienced, professional guide fluent in English and Vietnamese.

DAY 02: ARRIVE WASHINGTON D.C IN THE MORNING**(B/D)**

The blossoming cherry trees symbolize the arrival of spring and brighten the area surrounding the Jefferson Memorial on the Tidal Basin with their vibrant pale pink and white flowers. *The Cherry Blossom Festival 2012 is the 100th anniversary of these beautiful trees, is expected to be the biggest celebration ever.*

DAY 03: WASHINGTON D.C – VIRGINIA**(B/D)**

Drive to Mount Vernon, Virginia to visit George Washington's home, seeing the innovative Pioneer Farmer site with its 16-sided barn, important outbuildings, lush gardens, museums. Experience the natural wonders of Luray Caverns, the most popular cave in Eastern America since discovery in 1878. Stopping to see the Natural Bridge, one of the oldest tourist attractions in the United States. This natural wonder was formed when Cedar Creek carved out a gorge in the countryside, leaving behind the roof of a former cave or tunnel as a natural 200-foot tall limestone bridge.

DAY 04: VIRGINIA – TENNESSEE**(B/D)**

Visit Monticello Charlottesville – Thomas Jefferson's home, the great leader who gave the definition for this country. Continue driving into the state of Tennessee to come to Pigeon Forge, Tennessee attractions with favorites like Ripley's Aquarium of the Smokies, the Titanic Museum Attraction & WonderWorks. In the evening, we will go to *the famous dinner theater, Dixie Stampede, * to enjoy some real southern cuisine while we listen to bluegrass and country music and watch a live cowboy show.*

DAY 05: TENNESSE – NORTH CAROLINA / GREAT SMOKY MOUNTAINS – RUBY FALLS**(B/D)**

Visit Great Smoky Mountains National Park, which is among the oldest mountains in the world, formed 200-300 million years ago with elevations in the park ranging from 875 to 6,643 feet. We will also have the opportunity to ride a cable car to the peak of one of the mountains, giving a spectacular view of some of the highest mountains in the United States. Discover the Lost Sea, America's largest underground lake. At the mouth of the cave, will board a glass-bottomed boat for an exciting boat tour on this subterranean waterway. Continue our way to Ruby Falls, one of the most popular travel destinations in the southeast, a 145-foot high underground waterfall in a limestone cave at Lookout Mountain.

DAY 06: CHATTANOOGA – ROCK CITY – ATLANTA - GEORGIA**(B/D)**

We will drive to Chattanooga on to Rock City, a long trail featuring massive ancient rock formations and caves lined with gardens with over 400 native plant species. From the tops of some of the rock formations, we will have a stunning view of Rock City and the countryside of Tennessee. Continue to visit The World of Coca-Cola where you can experience the fascinating story of the world's best-known beverage brand in a dynamic, multimedia attraction. Journey to a place that has made as much history as it has chronicled during the CNN Studio tour

DAY 07: ATLANTA – HELENE – MYRTLE BEACH – SOUTH CAROLINA**(B/D)**

Visit town of Helene, a Bavaria town in the USA and one of the most beautiful sections of Northeast Georgia. It is a re-creation of an alpine village complete with cobblestone alleys and old-world towers. Continue to Myrtle Beach, a major resort town on the Atlantic Ocean coastline.
