Sightseeing includes:

- Auckland:** Centre of commerce and industry, nicknamed “the City of Sails “. Visit Auckland Domain, the city's oldest park, situated on an old volcano with views of the harbor. Mt Eden. Kelly Tarlton's Antarctic Encounter and Underwater World. The Sky Tower, the tallest building in the Southern Hemisphere.
- Rotoura:** Visit Te Puia, the New Zealand Māori. Arts and Crafts Institute, home of the world famous Pohutu geyser. The Rainbow Springs Nature Park offers a unique showcase of native flora and fauna while the Agrodome Sheep Show is an entertaining 'hands on' experience - an animated insight into New Zealand farming.
- Waitomo Caves:** Waitomo Glowworm Caves offer a magical boat ride through the glowworm grotto, illuminated by thousands of glowworms suspended from the cave ceiling.
- Sydney:** One of the world's most beautiful places. Visit Darling Harbour, Sydney Entertainment Center, Chinatown, the Sydney Aquarium and the Monorail, The Rock's. Drive to Bondi Beach. Visit Milson's Point for the best view of the Sydney Opera House, the beautiful Middle Harbour area and Spit Bridge from Seaforth Lookout. Manly Beach. Nan Tien Temple - the largest Budhist temple in the southern hemisper. Visit an Australian Wildlife Park where you can experience close encounters kangaroos, emus and koalas.



Blue Mountains: A mountainous region with spectacular gorges. Stop by Echo Point to see the Three Sisters rock formation towering over Jamison Valley and magnificent views over Megalong Valley. Walk on the valley floor boardwalk to get breathtaking views over the Grose Valley from Govetts Leap. Tour through mountain towns of Medlow Bath and Mt. Victoria.

Canberra: Nation's capital - a purpose built city, ultra modern, with imposing architecture yet a rural charm of lakeside, gardens and open spaces.

Melbourne: Heart of Australia's classic south, Melbourne has fantastic gardens, history, character and charm. Visit Fitzroy Gardens, Captain Cook's Cottage, the Royal Botanic Garden, Chinatown, Parliament House and Princess Theatre. Enjoy a ride on Puffing Billy, Australia's oldest steam locomotive to the Dandenong Ranges, which offer some of the most magnificent countryside in Victoria.
